
2010 FEMALE INVENTORY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE FEMALE INVENTORY

The 2010 Female Inventory is due to be run early January. There are a number of important considerations for the Female Inventory System for 2010 that MGBCS members that are recording cattle need to be made aware of.

Cut Off Date for 2010 Female Inventory

The cut off date for payment of Female Inventory will be June 30th each year. This means that members have until **June 30th 2010** to send their completed inventory forms and payment back to the MGBCS.

If inventory forms and payment have not been received by the MGBCS by June 30th, then all females over 2 years of age in the relevant herd will be made inactive and reinstatement fees will apply from July 1st 2010.

Members that have not paid their inventory in the lead up to June 30th will be given one official reminder, along with the monthly statements to notify them of non payment.

Once payment for inventory has been made, members will not be credited for animals that they take off their inventory after the payment date.

Exceptional Circumstances

Members who are in drought declared areas, are affected by BJD or are experiencing other valid exceptional circumstances must make an application to the MGBCS before June 30th in order to be eligible for consideration.

Once this application has been made a payment plan will be discussed.

Application for exceptional circumstances must be made annually. Exceptional Circumstance Certificates and/or a copy of the certificate/letter stating that the herd is in fact in quarantine due to BJD and unable to trade under normal circumstances, must be received by the MGBCS.

Reminder for Transfers

If members have and transfers to be made out of their herd before the Female Inventory is run, then these applications need to be received before January 11th in order for them to be processed before the inventory is run. Transfer forms can be accessed via
